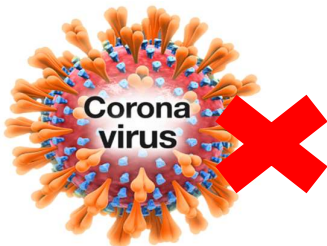

The different Alert Levels tell us what we must do to keep everyone safe from the COVID-19 virus.



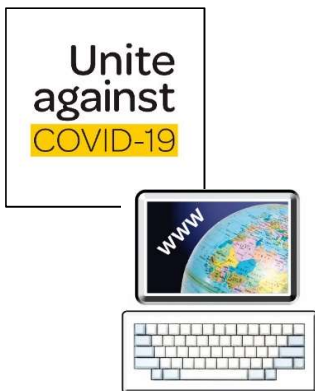
On the 13 May 2020 New Zealand moved into **Alert Level 2**.

The rules in this factsheet start from **Friday 29 May 2020 at 12 midday**.



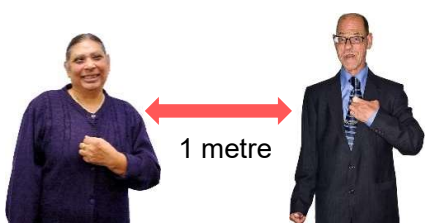

## Funerals and tangihanga

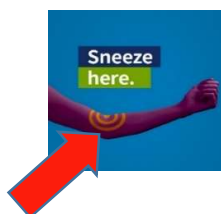


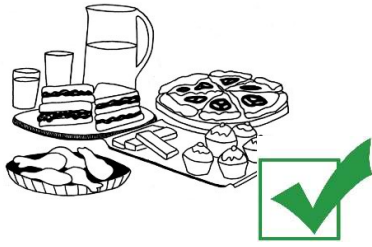
During Alert Level 2 up to **100 people** can attend funerals and tangihanga.



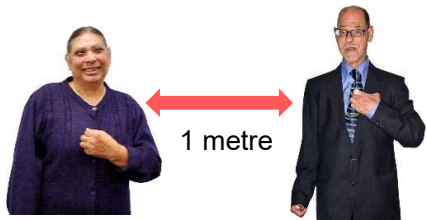
At the funeral or tangihanga you will need to:

- not stand or sit too close to other people
- wash your hands for at least 20 seconds
- use hand sanitizer if available
- sneeze or cough into a tissue or your elbow.





There can be food and drink after the service.



When eating and drinking people need to:

- not stand too close together
- be careful making and sharing the food.



Talk to the funeral director to find out the rules for going to a funeral or tangihanga.



The funeral director will be able to say what needs to happen to keep everyone safe from COVID-19.





It is very important to **stay home** if you are **feeling sick**.



If you are sick you must **not** go to the funeral or tangihanga.
